Pelizaeus-Merzbacher disease is one in a group of genetic disorders collectively known as leukodystrophies that affect growth of the myelin sheath, the fatty covering—which acts as an insulator—on nerve fibers in the CNS. PMD is a rare central nervous system disorder in which coordination, motor abilities, and intellectual function are delayed to variable extents.

Problem: Spasticity in legs

Goal: Prompt recognition and compensating

Action:

1. School staff members and school nurse should be readily available if needed and be up to date with the student’s current physician orders.
2. Physician restrictions should be in place with medical orders for medications and treatments.
3. Early vision screenings are important for the nurse to complete.
4. Accommodations may be needed to help the student be successful.
